 - a. Scripture study
 - b. RCIA catechesis classes open to everyone
 - c. Various presentation series (Faithful Citizenship; Advent; Lent)
2. Start up the youth group again by January 2013

SPIRITUAL LIFE and WORSHIP

Objectives:

1. Increase opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, to be noted in the liturgy schedule by November 1st, 2012
2. Coordinate parish-centered parishioner-led Scripture study and prayer groups by Winter 2012

2. Organize prayer groups to be led by parishioners (though still encouraged and promoted by the priest) by Winter 2012

Objectives:

1. Pastoral Council and finance council to decide, by Fall 2012, whether or not to explore this possibility
2. If the councils approve exploring this possibility, form School Committee by Winter 2012 to conduct a feasibility study
3. School Committee reports to the parishes and the parish councils on a periodic basis (goals, objectives, and timeline for the feasibility study to be established by the School Committee)
